Going forward, **prospective and current members will be required to complete their Safeguarding training before having any interaction with Those We Serve.** For assistance, please see contact information below. We are ready to help you!

Guidelines:

- We are available to provide individual or group training at a location convenient to members/volunteers as long as internet access is available. We can provide the devices for individuals to use.
- For those who have absolutely NO PUBLIC INTERACTION (NPI) with Those We Serve, we still must record this status on the CMG Connect database. Please contact one of us with name, address, phone and date of birth of members or volunteers who fall into this NPI category.
- For those who have previous Safe Environment certification with the Archdiocese of Milwaukee, we still must receive a record of that certificate so that we can provide access to complete a module for SVDP Safeguarding.

We will be contacting members who are not yet registered. Everyone associated with the Society of St. Vincent de Paul must be accounted for Safeguarding compliance.

Also, St. Vincent de Paul was born on April 24, 1581. To commemorate these events, the Society in the United States celebrates the last Sunday of April as **Ozanam Sunday**.

<u>St. Louise de Marillac</u> is the patron saint of all Christian social workers. Under the guidance of St. Vincent de Paul she became active in caring for the poor and in visiting the Confraternities of Charity. She cofounded the Daughters of Charity in 1633.

Conference Cares Program Progress

The Conference Cares Program started on March 1, 2024. This program eliminates the use of paper vouchers/gift certificates which were often altered, lost or misplaced. The transition to this streamlined redemption process has been going smoothly. Here are a few suggestions based on feedback:

- Ask store patrons to contact Beth 414-667-0240 or Cindy 414-462-7863 ext. 113 to check on status of the Cares Form rather than the stores. When needed, stores can be contacted on weekends or off-hours and for availability of merchandise.

- Need Conference Cares Forms or Appliance Vendor Forms? You can locate them on the password protected ServWare system. Click View> Files/Links>District to find the list of the forms.

Summary of Conference Cares Process

1. Determine items to be redeemed at the Thrift Store.

2. Complete Cares Form. List specific items OR enter a general \$\$ amount for furniture, household items, and clothing.

3. Provide Neighbor with the Instruction Card- 'Care Card'. Picture ID is required.

4. Submit Conference Cares Form to Beth. Several options available.

5. Neighbor provides picture ID to Customer Service counter. Staff retrieves shopping list based on the information on the submitted Cares Form. Valid for 30 days from data entry date.

ServWare Training Dates


