Energy Assistance

The 2021-2022 Milwaukee Co. **Energy Assistance** benefit season is from October 1, 2022 through May 15, 2023. Eligible residents can apply for a one-time payment to help cover a portion of their energy bill. Other benefits to reduce utility costs may also be available. Milwaukee Emergency Rental Assistance (MERA) Program: As of July 1, 2023, the Social Development Commission is <u>no longer accepting applications</u> for the MERA Program.
