Conference Cares Program Begins in March

The Conference Cares Program started on March 1, 2024. This new process will eliminate the use of paper vouchers/gift certificates and will put an end to altered, lost or misplaced certificates and streamline the redemption process. Summary of Conference Cares Process

- 1. Determine items to be redeemed at the Thrift Store.
- 2. Complete Cares Form. List specific items OR enter a general \$\$ amount for furniture, household items, and clothing.
- 3. Provide Neighbor with the Instruction Card- 'Care Card'. Picture ID and proof of current address required.
- 4. Submit Conference Cares Form to Beth. Several options available.
- 5. Neighbor provides picture ID and proof of current address to Customer Service counter. Staff retrieves shopping list based on the information on the submitted Cares Form.

Valid for 30 days from data entry date.

Financial Literacy Worshop Saturday, March 23 10AM-1PM St. John Cathedral, 831 N. Van Buren St.

By sponsoring a financial literacy workshop, members of Gesu conference want to provide an opportunity for those in need to gain an understanding of basic financial information that many of us take for granted.

Body

Vincentians provide for basic needs or assist in crisis situations, but perhaps the greatest gift is a path toward self-sufficiency and away from the cycle of poverty. Members of Gesu conference saw this workshop as a way to inform and empower neighbors in need.

As conference President Bob Friday noted, "Some never hear about things like banks and savings accounts, so they use check-cashing stores to cash checks and get what are supposed to be short-term loans. They end up losing their hard-earned money to fees for cashing those checks, and to extremely high interest rates for the loans, to the point where their balance is a neverending albatross around their neck."

The workshop will be taught by representatives of Brewery Credit Union and includes topics like budgeting, making credit card payments more effectively, checking account basics and warnings about check cashing stores. The event will be held at the Cathedral of St. John the Evangelist to accommodate accessibility. Registration is requested as lunch and materials are provided.

This workshop is open to all! Please **share the flyer** with Neighbors in Need as part of your home visit. Post flyers on bulletin boards, church bulletins, businesses, libraries, food pantries or other sites where others might benefit.

Your prayers are kindly requested so that God may grant success to the efforts and outcomes of this event. With God's help, we can get people started on the road to financial stability.


